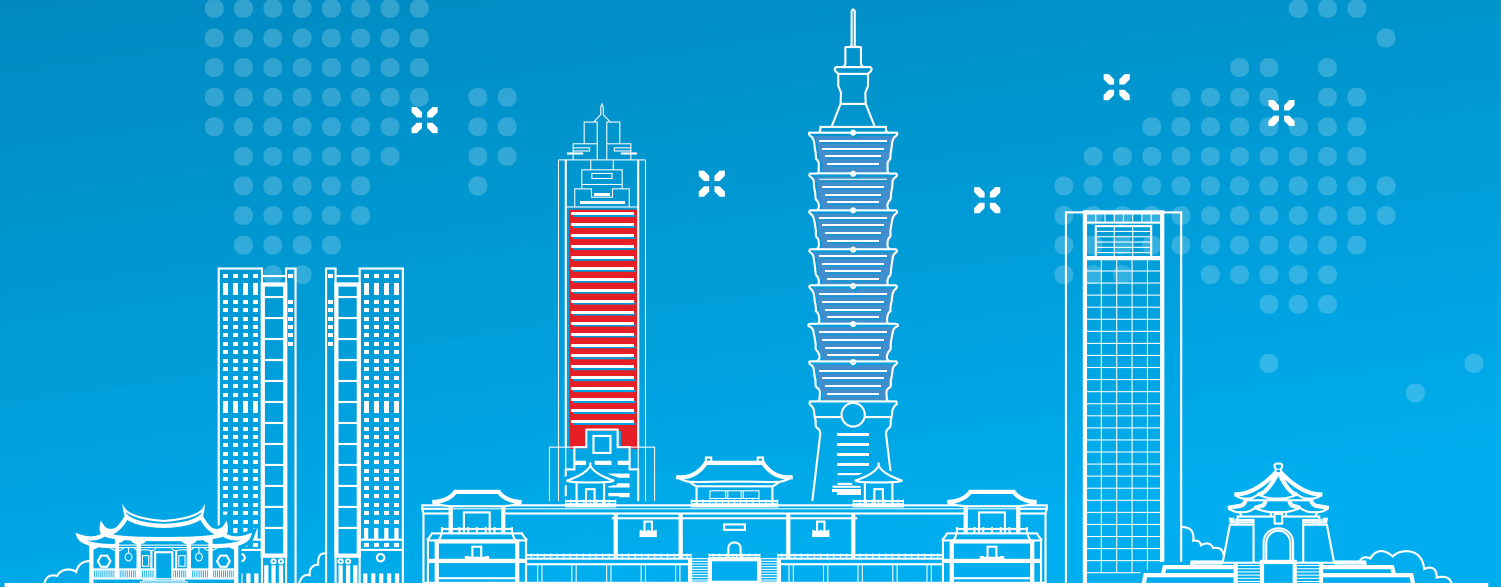
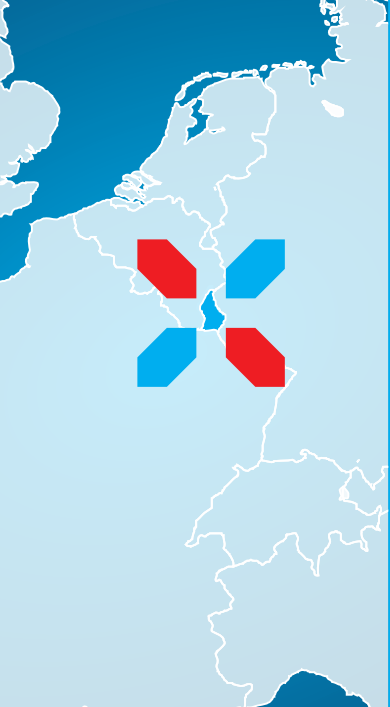

ICT + CYBERSECURITY

Excellent connectivity and outstanding infrastructure, Luxembourg is a trusted data hub (*with 40% of Europe's high density Tier IV datacenters*) for digital business. The country is recognized for its cybersecurity expertise which is a cornerstone for the data driven economy. 1st EU country that signed the national AI collaboration with NVIDIA.



FINANCE AND FINTECH

The world's first Green Exchange was launched by Luxembourg, one of the leading financial centres and 2nd biggest investment fund centre in the world after the USA. A series of agreements for the avoidance of double taxation and the prevention of fiscal evasion with respect to taxes on income and on fortune are in place, including one with Taiwan.

China Airlines, KYMCO, TSRC, ASUS Cloud choose Luxembourg for their European operations thanks to its well-connected logistics ecosystem and state-of-the-art infrastructure.

Luxembourg's flagship start-up supporting program Fit 4 Start and its innovative approach also attracted start-ups like Odysseus Space and CYBAVO to setup in Luxembourg.

- 1989** — Inauguration of China Airlines' first European cargo center in Luxembourg
- 1994** — Establishment of Paul Wurth Taiwan Branch in Kaohsiung
- 2003** — MOU between Luxembourg Stock Exchange and Taiwan Stock Exchange Corporation
- 2007** — Launch of the Joint Business Council Luxembourg - Taiwan by the Luxembourg Chamber of Commerce and the Chinese International Economic Cooperation Association
- 2009** — Inauguration of the Luxembourg Trade and Investment Office in Taipei

Launch of the "Lux GDRs Taiwan Index" at Luxembourg Stock Exchange
- 2010** — Creation of CB Ceratizit Luxembourg SA, a joint venture between Ceratizit Group and CB Carbide from Taiwan

MOU between the Financial Supervisory Commission of Taiwan (FSC) and the Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier Luxembourg (CSSF)
- 2011** — Inauguration of TSRC's European headquarter in Luxembourg
- 2014** — MOU between Luxembourg Stock Exchange and Taipei Exchange (formally known as GreTai Securities Market)
- 2018** — Launch of the Working Holiday Programme between Luxembourg and Taiwan
