Three types of actions

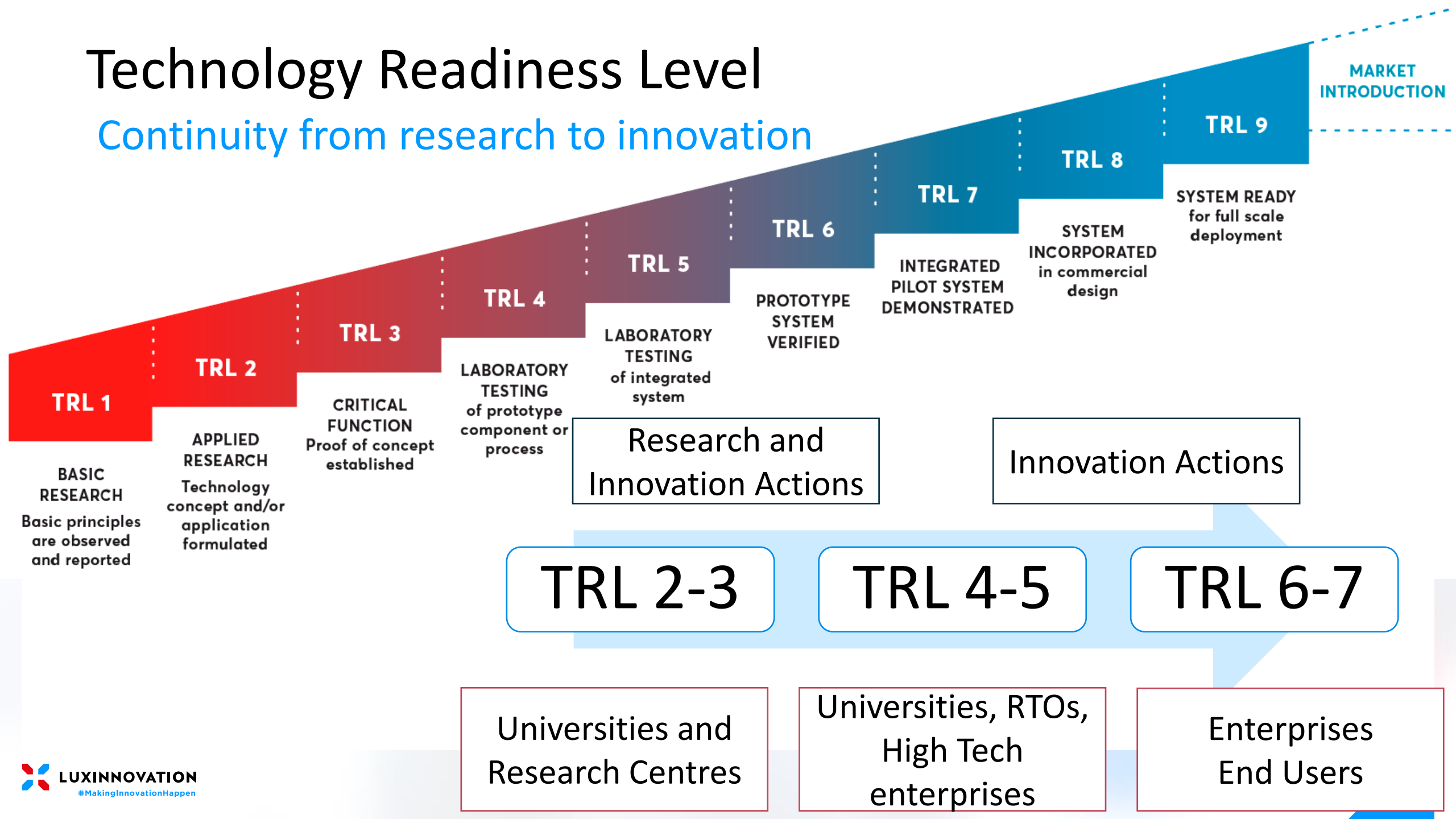
And funding rates



- **Research and Innovation Actions:** test your solutions to develop a proof-of-concept, a prototype
100 % funding
- **Innovation Action:** bring your proof of concept closer to its real life application
60% funding (100% to not for profit)
- **Coordination and Support Actions:** network with your colleagues on key policy issues
100 % funding

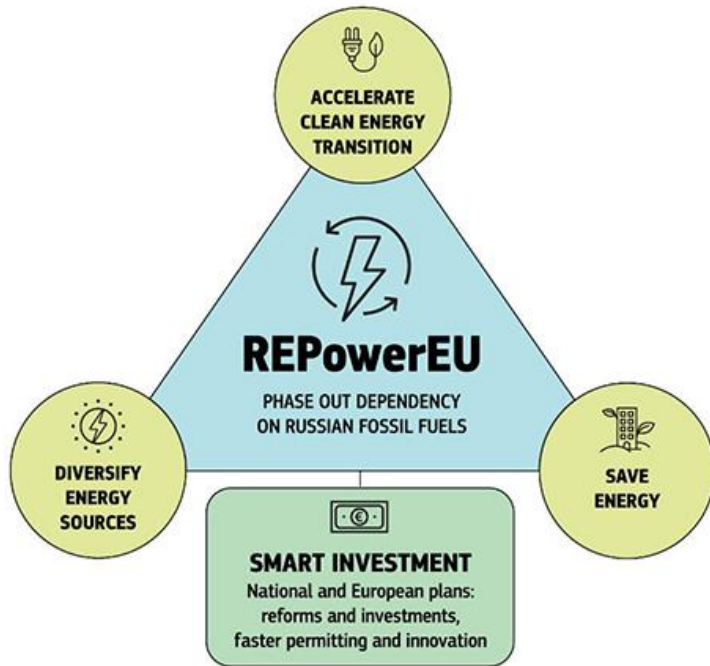

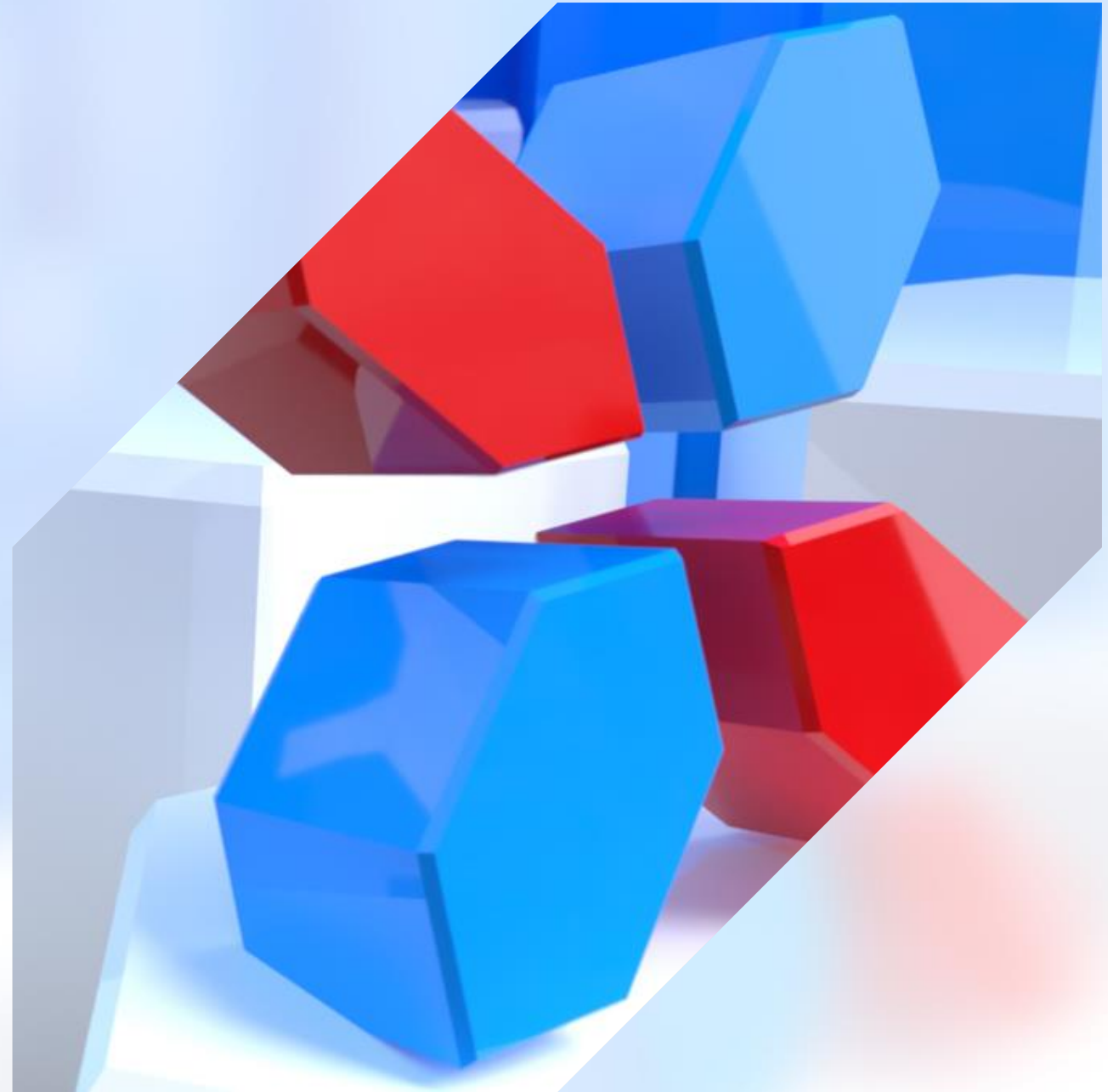

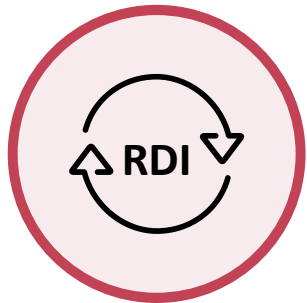

The coordinator

The coordinator is the main drive behind the preparation of the proposal

They are recognised experts in their field

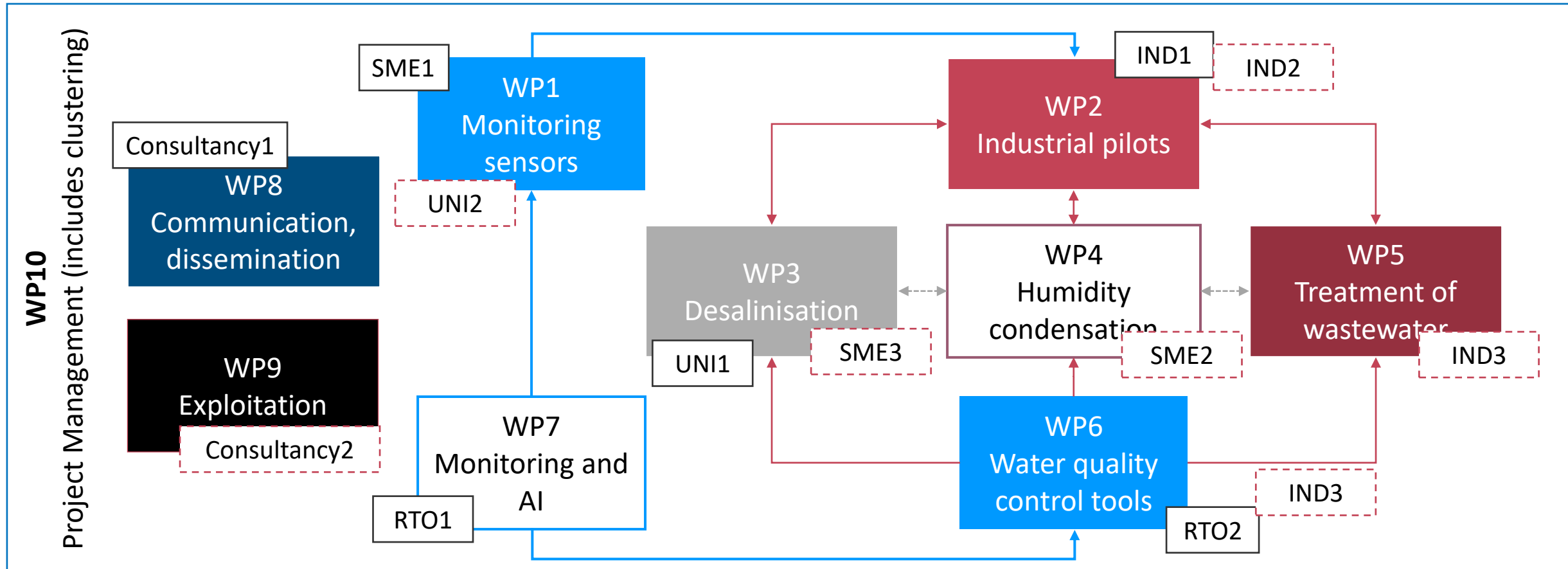
They have sufficient resources and support mechanisms to gather a group of experts and to coordinate the innovation efforts of their teams to achieve the goal of the project



TIP: don't start as a coordinator, start participating to tasks in which you feel confident and gradually take more management responsibilities!
