EU R&I funding programme 2021-2027: €95.5 B for 7 years, of which <u>35%</u> for funding climate change related projects






- Research and Innovation Actions: test your solutions to develop a proof-of-concept, a prototype





### Building a European proposal – various roles

The coordinator

The coordinator is the main drive behind the preparation of the proposal

They are recognised experts in their field

They have sufficient resources and support mechanisms to gather a group of experts and to coordinate the innovation efforts of their teams to achieve the goal of the project




Took tipe: don't start as a coordinator, start participating to tasks in which you feel confident and gradually take more management responsibilities!
